



## WHAT IS WATER AND ENERGY FOR FOOD?

Water and Energy for Food (WE4F) is a joint international initiative of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), the European Union (EU), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of the Netherlands, the Norwegian Agency for Development Cooperation (Norad), Sweden through the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida), and the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID).

WE4F, through its Regional Innovation Hubs, provides financial support, technical assistance, and investment facilitation to water-food, energy-food, and water-energy-food innovations.

The supported innovations impact smallholder farmers, helping them unlock missing inputs, finance, technology, and markets. By using these innovations, farmers and food companies can enhance their climate resilience and reduce CO2 emissions.

Through Calls for Innovations and publicprivate partnerships, the Regional Innovation Hubs work with innovative SMEs in the waterfood-energy nexus. The SMEs receive financial and technical assistance, which helps them unlock the potential for positive impact by producing more high-quality food with less resources and by promoting the holistic management of natural resources.

Through investment facilitation, SMEs access private sector investment which helps them scale their businesses and expand operations.
