The Global Programme operates in <u>five</u> interrelated outputs:


- Transformative agricultural policy: improving the (policy) framework conditions for a sustainable transformation of agricultural and food systems
- Institutional anchoring of proven solutions: scaling up successful practices to help consolidate and institutionalize proven solutions and innovations

- Advocacy and empowerment for transformation: strengthening voices and involving interests of change agents (especially women & youth)
- Financing the transformation: strengthening of processes for the expansion and conversion of financing for sustainable agricultural and food systems
- 5 Linking the different levels of transformation: providing impetus for transformation at regional and global level
