Objective

Transformation processes to sustainable agricultural systems are strengthened in selected partner countries and at the global level.

The Global Programme operates in **five** interrelated outputs:

- 1. Transformative agricultural policy:** improving the (policy) framework conditions for a sustainable transformation of agricultural and food systems
- 2. Institutional anchoring of proven solutions:** scaling up successful practices to help consolidate and institutionalize proven solutions and innovations
- 3. Advocacy and empowerment for transformation:** strengthening voices and involving interests of change agents (especially women & youth)
- 4. Financing the transformation:** strengthening of processes for the expansion and conversion of financing for sustainable agricultural and food systems
- 5. Linking the different levels of transformation:** providing impetus for transformation at regional and global level
