Responsibilities and Duties

- Monitor and evaluate project activities, ensuring that objectives are met and report on progress to the component lead.
- Foster strong partnerships with relevant stakeholders, including regional organizations, government agencies, and non-state actors.
- Ensure compliance with GIZ policies and procedures, and maintain high standards of project management.

Required qualifications, competences, and experience

Qualifications

- A minimum of a Masters degree in environmental science, geography, international relations, law, political science, or a related field.
- Strong ability to handle complex work environments with competing tasks that require prioritization and scheduling.

- Ability to work collaboratively in a multicultural environment.
- Familiarity with MS Office programs and project management tools.
