Queries received and clarity/responses are below:

	Query	Response
1	Nature of Events:	The events will vary and will include conferences, workshops, planning, and training sessions. Additionally, there will be site visits to training locations. These events will take place in different parts of the country, as the project spans across multiple regions.
2	Duration of Events	Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a clear-cut answer regarding the duration of the events, as some will be organized in partnership with our stakeholders. The duration will therefore depend on the specific arrangements for each event.

3	Site Visits	The site visits will take place within South Africa, and the exact locations will be determined based on where the appointed service providers for training are operating.
4	Recording of Events	The recording approach will depend on the nature of the event. For example, at some events, the focus may be on interviewing beneficiaries, while at others, it may involve recording the actual event proceedings. Beneficiaries will either be present at the events or at the training sites.
5	Impact Stories and Videos	The impact stories will highlight beneficiaries sharing how the training has transformed their lives, particularly in terms of the opportunities they have been able to pursue afterward. The videos will consist of infographics showcasing the project's impact. On average, these videos have ranged from 10 to 20 minutes in length.
