Project Name: Strengthening Public Finance and Financial Markets (FFM) in Iraq

1. Project Background

The Support to Public Financial Management and Financial Market (FFM) Project in Iraq is a multi-donor action commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), co-funded by the European Union (EU) and implemented by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH.

The government of Iraq has defined comprehensive reform measures to embark on an inclusive development path based on stable and accountable institutions. The aim is to diversify domestic revenue mobilization from near complete dependence on Oil Revenue. To this end, the Project is supporting the government's effort to modernize the non-oil domestic revenue generation system through institutional and human capacity development.

The FFM program has four components, and the Fiscal Reform Component is the conduit through which the program is supporting the Government of Iraq to modernize the non-oil revenue mobilization system. The aim is to support the establishment of a transparent and accountable revenue generation system that is capable of mobilizing revenue in a fair manner for service delivery to the citizens, especially the vulnerable women and children who are mostly affected by the prolonged conflict.

In addition, the FFM Program through its component one will support some key counterparts namely, the Finance of Finance (MoF), the General Commission of Taxes (GCT), and the Iraq Customs Authority (ICA). The Program supports the government in doing political analysis based on the following: (i) the economic and social effects of a particular tax type and how it can influence the political atmosphere in the country, (ii) careful analysis of how the imposing of a particular tax can lead to changing political landscape and support, and (iii) evidence-based revenue projections methodologies developed to scientifically estimates the resource envelop to meet the overall budgets and avoid fiscal distortion in the fiscal year budget and resource allocation.

Overall, this multi-donor action emphasizes developing the long-term abilities of its partners such as the Iraqi Ministry of Finance is placed on the key revenue-generating institutions and other non-oil revenue-generating departments and commissions with strong potential for transforming the revenue base from near complete dependence on oil revenue to non-oil revenue.

2. The objective of this training package:

- To equip the Customs officials with essential skills to navigate the automated system effectively, minimizing operational disruptions and maximizing operational efficiency
- The specialized IT training of the officers will enhance their capacity in modernizing customs operations and helping to improve revenue collection
- The specialized IT training for the customs officers will enhance the capacity of the officer to detect fraud and improve operational security by streamlining procedures of cargo control, transit of goods, and clearance of goods



- Facilitating trade efficiency and competitiveness by substantially reducing transaction time and costs, with improved transparency in customs transactions
- Promoting sustainable development by cutting down on the use of paper, through the use of electronic transactions and documents

3. The company needs to provide the following:

- Practical experience in software development to effectively teach real-world applications in custom.
- He should have hands-on experience in developing software projects using and working with libraries, frameworks, and tools commonly used in the industry.
- Experience in teaching or training, whether in a classroom setting.

b. Tools and Equipment

- Provide a letter directed to GIZ exploring:
 - > Your company is interested and will participate in the tender.
 - > Full names of owner and representatives, with their signatures' samples.
 - The stamp samples.
