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1 General information

2 Brief information on the project

The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) in Iraq assists the Iraqi Government on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). GIZ offers a wide range of services to governments enabling them to perform reform measures, to private sector entities in order to lead economic growth, and to international institutions to implement their development objectives. The BMZ has commissioned GIZ to implement the Global Programme “Centres for Migration and Development” (ZME) in Nigeria, Ghana, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, Jordan, Iraq, Pakistan and Indonesia. The programme aims to enable partner structures to support people engaging in regular migration for work and training purposes, voluntary return, and sustainable reintegration as well as regional migration in a target group-specific and sustainable manner.

ZME is a follow-on measure to the Global Programme Migration for Development (PME) which had been commissioned by BMZ and implemented by GIZ between 2015 and 2023. In Iraq, the implementation of ZME centers around the two migration advisory centers, the Iraqi-German Centre for Jobs, Migration and Reintegration (GMAC) in Baghdad and the German Centre for Jobs, Migration and Reintegration in the Kurdistan Region in Iraq (GMAC) in Erbil, Kurdistan Region of Iraq.

The government implementation partners of ZME Iraq are the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (MoLSA) of Federal Iraq (FI), and the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (MoLSA) of the Kurdistan Region of Iraq (KRI). Potentially the cooperation will be extended to other government actors with relevance in the field of migration and reintegration over the course of the implementation period of ZME.

To achieve the project goals, a new office building for visitors and returnees will be newly constructed in Halabja (77m²).

This building will be built using lightweight construction, consisting of steel frames and sandwich panels. It will include two office rooms, a kitchen, WC facilities, and a storage room.

3 Tasks of the Consultant

The engineer will supervise the construction site throughout the whole construction duration. He/ She is required to be present on site every day and supervise the construction work and construction company.

The main tasks of the consultant will be to:

1. Provide overall technical assistance to the GIZ construction project, during the implementation and monitoring.
2. Responsible to ensure that effective implementation, monitoring and supervision tools are developed and implemented.
3. Responsible to ensure effective quality control systems are in place and the construction company works in compliance with drawings, technical specifications and GIZ quality standards.
4. Takes responsibility for overall progress and use of resources.
5. Identifies, manages, risks, and initiates corrective action where necessary in close coordination with GIZ project engineer, so that maximum client benefit is achieved.
6. Prepares daily, interim - final project and handover reports and maintain the relevant project records in coordination with the GIZ project engineer.
7. Coordinates with GIZ, directorates and/or authorities points of contact (PoC) in Halabja District
8. Ensuring proper and timely actions from both, GIZ and Partner's side.
9. Prepares in close coordination with GIZ a sound handing over of facilities to project beneficiaries.
10. Close cooperation with the respective GIZ project engineer is expected.
11. Necessary Solutions for problems during the implementation must be independently developed and to be coordinated with the respective GIZ project engineer.
